### *Pastor's Paragraph*



#### **Looking Ahead with Hope**

As we step into 2026, many Southern Baptist churches are walking through a season of transition. Some congregations are smaller than they once were. Others are praying through the process of calling a new pastor. Others are relocating. These moments can feel uncertain--but they are also moments where God often does His deepest work.

The Bible reminds us, "*Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it*" (1 Thessalonians 5:34). The Lord who planted our church has not stepped away from it. He is still present, still guiding, and still faithful.

#### **To the Faithful Few Who Continue to Serve**

Commitment matters in a smaller Southern Baptist congregation. Showing up, praying, giving, and serving--these are not small things. God has always used faithful people, not large crowds, to accomplish His purposes.

Jesus said, "*Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them*" (Matthew 18:20). A church's strength is not measured by attendance, but by its faithfulness to Christ and His mission.

This season may require courage and a willingness to move forward together, trusting God for what lies ahead rather than holding tightly to what once was.

#### **Seeking God's Wisdom in Calling New Leadership**

The search for a new pastor is not just a committee task--it is a church-wide calling. Scripture gives us this promise: "*If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally...and it shall be given him*" (James 1:5).

This is a time for united prayer. Pray for clarity. Pray for wisdom. Pray for the man God is already preparing to shepherd Calvary Baptist. And pray for hearts that are open to God's leading, even when the path forward feels unfamiliar. When our church prays together, it stands firmly on the foundation God provides.

#### **A Call to Action for 2026**

As you move into this new year, we encourage every member to take an active step forward:

- **Commit to pray daily** for your church and for God's direction in calling new leadership.
- **Support one another faithfully**, showing grace, unity, and encouragement during this season
- **Engage in the mission** God has placed before you--loving your community, sharing the gospel, and serving with joy.
- **Trust God fully**, believing His promise: "*Trust in the Lord with all thine heart...and he shall direct thy paths*" (Proverbs 3:5-6).

Maintaining good church health is not about reclaiming the past. It is about faithfully stepping in to the future God is shaping right now.

As 2026 begins, be encouraged. The future is bright--not because the road is easy, but because the Lord is faithful. With prayerful hearts and obedient steps, Calvary Baptist church can move forward together into all that God has prepared.




